DED#	DATA ELEMENT NAME	FORMAT
<b>SB22</b>	<b>STUDENT-ACADEMIC-STANDING</b>	<b>X</b>
This element indicates the student's academic standing at the <u>end of the current term</u> (the term being reported.)		

Coding	Meaning
1	Academic Good Standing
3	Progress Probation (percent of withdrawals / incompletes)
4	Academic Probation (low grade point average)
5	Both Progress and Academic Probation
6	Progress Dismissal / Disqualification
7	Academic Dismissal / Disqualification
8	Progress and Academic Dismissal / Disqualification
X	Status unknown / uncollected
Y	Not Applicable: Student is not in 'Academic Good Standing' but has attempted less than 12 semester / 18 quarter units (Title 5, 55754, Standards for Probation.)
If a student falls into more than one of the above categories, use the highest value. For example, a student who is on both 'Academic Probation' and 'Progress Dismissal / Disqualification' should be reported as a '6' rather than a '4'.
